

FFA INFLUENCES G4TV TO REMOVE THE MAN SHOW FROM PRIMETIME SUNDAY 10 PM TIMESLOT

G4TV has now cut The Man Show's airtime by 6 hours per week and the show has been totally removed from primetime

Supporters' emails and Florida Family Association's communications with advertisers have influenced G4TV to remove The Man Show from its primetime Sunday 10:00 to 11:00 PM timeslot. FFA has now influenced G4TV to remove The Man Show from 6 hours of primetime scheduling per week. The program no longer airs during primetime.

G4TV dropped The Man Show from the Sunday 10:00 –11:00 PM time slot the third week of October.

CONGRESSMAN BILIRAKIS PROPOSES LAW IN RESPONSE TO FOREIGN USF STUDENTS ACCUSED OF TRANSPORTING BOMBS

Congressman Gus Bilirakis of Palm Harbor, Florida has introduced a bill to address national security measures that came to light after two foreign-born University of South Florida students were arrested on August 4th for carrying explosives near a military base in South Carolina.

"My legislation will more concretely align the responsibilities and roles of federal agencies and academic institutions in tracking foreign students and ensuring they are here doing what they came here to do," Bilirakis told The Tampa Tribune.

It is encouraging to know that Congressman Bilirakis

FFA OPPOSES "GOLDEN COMPASS" MOVIE DESCRIBED AS "ATHESIM FOR KIDS"

Florida Family Association launched an email campaign to warn parents about a movie entitled The Golden Compass. The Email Alert also encouraged supporters to voice their concerns about the movie to producers and theatres.

New Line Cinema, a Time Warner Company, released the movie entitled The Golden Compass on December 7th just in time for Christmas. The movie has been described as '*atheism for kids*'.

The Golden Compass is based on the first book of a trilogy entitled '*His Dark Materials*' written by Phillip Pullman. Pullman is a militant atheist and secular humanist who despises C. S. Lewis and the '*Chronicles of Narnia*.' His motivation for writing this trilogy was specifically to counteract Lewis' symbolisms of Christ portrayed in the Narnia series.

Pullman left little doubt about his intentions when he said in a 2003 interview that "*My books are about Killing God....*" In Pullman's final book a boy and girl kill God so they can do as they please. The movie is a watered down version of the first book entitled '*His Dark Materials*'.

"*The problem (with this movie) is that kids may see the film and ask their parents for the books,*" said Kiera McCaffrey, director of communications for the Catholic League. "*The trilogy of books, especially the third volume, promotes atheism and denigrates Christianity. This is central to the plot.*"

G4TV DROPS THE MAN SHOW FROM PRIMETIME

Additionally, TVGuide.com reports The Man Show has been removed from the 10:00 – 11:00 PM timeslot for the next two Sundays. This latest schedule change appears to be the result of FFA's last G4TV email campaign which influenced Toshiba, Countrywide Loans, Select Comfort and other advertisers to drop The Man Show.

This is the second time Florida Family Association's monitoring efforts have influenced G4TV to remove The Man Show from primetime. In January 2007, G4TV removed The Man Show from the Monday through Friday 10:00 to 11:00 PM time slot after advertisers received thousands of emails in response to several Florida Family Association Email Alerts.

G4TV has now completely removed The Man Show from the Monday through Friday plus Sunday 10:00 to 11 PM schedule.

Bottom line: Supporters' emails and FFA'S daily communications with advertisers have influenced G4TV to completely remove The Man Show from primetime viewing.

G4TV is a game show channel that is watched by millions of children. The Man Show is one of the most pornographic, disgusting and degrading television shows ever aired on unrestricted advertiser supported television. Children and teenagers who tune in to watch the gaming on G4TV are exposed to this hideous program.

Florida Family Association initially monitored The Man Show when it first aired on Comedy Central. Comedy Central cancelled The Man Show after Florida Family Association influenced approximately Ninety-five percent (95%) of their advertisers to drop the program. Comedy Central sold the reruns to Comcast who owns G4TV. G4TV continues to air reruns of The Man Show during the 3:00 to 3:30 AM and other random late night AM time slots. Florida Family Association will continue to monitor the show and contact advertisers.

ONE PERSON'S EMAIL CHANGED VERIZON'S TELEVISION POLICY

This is a great example of what one person can do. D.B. (name withheld) a Florida Family Association email supporter, contacted FFA regarding concerns about R rated previews that ran during Verizon's "on demand" feature while she was trying to select a family movie.

Her initial contact with Verizon was unfruitful so she emailed Florida Family Association. "I don't know where to go if Verizon is not going to change this
